

Please review AAESA's policy related to face coverings and symptom screening. We ask that you complete the form below indicating your understanding and agreement prior to your child attending school in person.

Part 1: Face Coverings

For the health and safety of our students and staff, **face coverings are required** under Executive Order 2020-142 **for all staff and students** unless medically exempt. Reusable face coverings must be washed and your child must have a clean face covering at the start of each day.

I understand that my child must wear a face covering unless my child is medically exempt.

I understand that if my child wears a reusable, cloth face covering, it must be washed daily.

Please note: GSRP students may remove facial coverings when in the classroom, if allowable by the local district. GSRP staff will wear facial coverings at all times unless eating or outdoors.

A physician statement is required if a family requests a medical exemption to the face covering mandate. Please reach out to your child's teacher or building administrator if your child needs a medical exemption. Families who do not want to send their child to school with a face covering but are not medically exempt, may access a remote instructional option.

Part 2: Daily Symptom Screening

For the health and safety of our students, our **local public health department requires students be screened for symptoms of COVID-19 before entering the school**. We ask that you complete the steps of the student screening (attached) prior to sending your child to school or any school activities.

I commit to screening my child daily for the 2020-21 school year, unless otherwise directed.

I understand that it is my responsibility to call my child's school as soon as possible to let them know if my child is not going to school for potential COVID-19 symptoms.

Please note: All AAESA programs have also established screening procedures, including a temperature check upon arrival at school. This is intended to be an added protection, not the primary screening process.

Part 4: Emergency Contact

Students who exhibit symptoms at school will be quarantined and may not ride transportation home. Please be sure you have provided at least 3 updated emergency contacts with phone numbers on your GSRP Child Information Card.
